Online Bids are hereby invited on behalf of the Director IISWC, Dehradun in two bid system (Technical & Financial) from the eligible Government registered firms/ contractors for **“Development of Gravity/Pressurized Irrigation system in Bilkhet village its testing and commissioning for irrigation purpose”.**

**A. Instruction for online bid submission**

1. The firm shall submit its online bid through Central Public Procurement Portal (<https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>) only.
2. The Technical Bid should be uploaded in prescribed format as per **Annexure-IV**. All documents referred in the Technical Bid format should be uploaded alongwith Technical bid failing which the firm shall be rejected. The price bid of only those firms shall be opened which shall be declared as responsive bid after evaluation of technical bid by a duly constituted committee of IISWC.
3. The Price Bid should be uploaded in the **prescribed BoQ**.
4. The firm shall deposit Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) only in the form of demand draft in favour of **“ICAR (Unit) CSWCRTI, Dehradun”** payable at Dehradun. The scanned copy of Demand Draft should be uploaded alongwith online bid and original demand draft is to be sent by Speed/Regd. Post to the Asstt. Admn. Officer (S&P), ICAR-Indian Institute of Soil & Water Conservation, 218-Kaulagarh Road, Dehradun – 248195 in sealed cover envelope superscribing “Technical Bid of Development of Gravity/Pressurized Irrigation system in Bilkhet village, its testing and commissioning for irrigation purpose” on or before the last date and time of submission of online bid. In case of late receipt of demand draft, it shall not be accepted/received and the tender bid shall be considered as unresponsive and will be rejected.
5. Firms registered under MSME/NSIC shall be exempted for deposition of EMD. Bid Securing declaration form should be submitted by the MSME/NSIC. **Annexure II**
6. The firm shall submit scanned copy of Declaration in **Annexure-V** in Non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.100/- duly notarized alongwith Technical Bid. The original copy be submitted alongwith the demand draft of EMD as per Sl.No.1 above. In case of late receipt of certificate, it shall not be accepted/received and the tender bid shall be considered as unresponsive and will be rejected.
7. The firm shall submit the **Enlistment Order** from any Central Govt/State Govt/PSU alongwith technical bid which should be valid at least up to the completion period of the job.
8. The firm shall submit **GST** registration certificate and **PAN** along with the technical bid.
9. The firm shall submit self attested ITR/Audited Statement of Account for the last three financial years (2017-18, 2018-19 & 2019-20) along with the technical bid.
10. All the documents being uploaded alongwith Technical bid should be signed by authorised signatory with seal of the firm.

## **B. Main Terms and conditions:**

1. The terms and conditions of the contract are those contained in the general conditions of contract applicable to the contracts placed by the IISWC as detailed in the tender forms and its schedules. The firm shall quote its rates in the prescribed BoQ if it is in a position to execute the requisite work as per scope of work.
2. Each bidder should submit only one bid for this tender.
3. The firm to whom contract will be finally awarded shall not transfer or sub-let the contract to other firm.
4. The EMD of unsuccessful bidder shall be returned only after the completion of codal formalities on receipt of written request.
5. In case the successful bidder does not accept the offer within the prescribed time period, the EMD shall be forfeited. No interest on EMD shall be paid by the Institute.
6. The firms are being permitted to give tenders in consideration of the stipulations on his part that after submitting its Tenders, it will not resile from its offer or modify the terms and conditions thereof. If the Tenderer fails to observe and comply with the foregoing stipulations the amount of EMD will be forfeited. In the event of the offer made by the tenderer not being accepted, the amount of EMD will be refunded to it after applying for the same.
7. Annexure/supporting document of the tender form (*Duly signed and sealed by the firm*) should be uploaded with online bids. In the event of the space provided on the schedule form being insufficient for the required purposes, additional pages may be added. Each additional page must be numbered consecutively and be signed in full by the tenderer with proper seal of the firm. In such cases reference to the additional pages must be made in the tender form. If any modification of the schedule is considered necessary it should be communicated by means of a separate letter alongwith the tenders.
8. Tenders are liable to be ignored if complete information as required is not given therein or if the particulars asked for in the schedules to the tenders are not fully filled in. Individual signing the tenders or other documents connected with the contract may specify whether he signs it in the capacity of (i) a sole proprietor of the firm of constituted attorney of such sole proprietor, or (ii) a partner of the firm. If it is partnership, in such case he must have authority to execute the document on the behalf of the firm by virtue of the partnership agreement or power of attorney or (iii) constituted attorney of the firm if it is a company.
9. In case of partnership firms, where no authority has been given to any partner to execute the contract/ agreement concerning the business of the partnership, the tenders and all other related document must be signed by every partner of the firm. A person signing the tender form or any other documents forming part of the contract on behalf of another shall be deemed to warranty that he has authority to bind such other and if, on enquiry it appears that the persons so signing had no authority to do so, the IISWC shall without prejudice to other civil and criminal remedies cancel the contract and hold the signatory liable for all risk and costs and damages.
10. Tenders will be opened online by the authorized officers. Bidders have two options to participate in tendering process at the time of opening of Bids. Bidders can come at the place of opening of bids (electronically) as done in the conventional tender process or he can visualize the process online without physically being present at IISWC. The name and address of the representative who would be attending the opening of the tenders on firm's behalf should be indicated in tender document. Name and address of permanent representative of the tenderer, if any, may also be indicated.

11. In accordance with O.M. No. 29(1)/2014-PPD dated 28.01.2014 of Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, bids quoting "Nil" consideration/service charges shall be treated as unresponsive and will not be considered.
12. **Performance Security Deposit of 03% of the total amount of work order is to be deposited by the successful bidder to whom contract is awarded for a period of six months.** The Performance Security Deposit is to be deposited only after receiving a communication from the IISWC. In the event of non-deposition of the same, the earnest money will be forfeited and contract shall be cancelled. The performance security shall be returned to the firm after successful completion of contract i.e. six months + 60 days. No interest on Performance Security shall be paid by the IISWC. However, the EMD so deposited may be allowed to adjust against the performance security of the successful bidder.
13. No change/revision whatsoever in rates once quoted shall be accepted during the tenure of contract including extended period of contract under any circumstances.
14. **The criteria for selection of Lowest Bid (L-1 bidder) shall be the lowest rate of the work.** In case of more than one successful lowest bidders(L-1), the criteria of selection shall be the maximum experience in government department **in civil works**.
15. GST or any other tax applicable or made applicable after awarding the contract in respect of this contract shall be payable by contractor and IISWC will not entertain any claim whatsoever in this respect. However, the income tax or any other tax which is as per the rules of the Govt. of India shall be deducted at source from the final bill of the successful tenderer, as per rules/ instructions made applicable from time to time by government.
16. Acceptance of offer of successful bidder by the Institute will be communicated by fax/speed/registered post or any other form of communication.
17. If a tenderer does not accept the offer, after issue of letter of award by IISWC within 15 (fifteen) days, the offer made shall be deemed to be withdrawn without any notice & earnest money shall be forfeited.
18. IISWC does not pledge itself to accept the lowest or any other tenders and also reserve to itself the right of accepting the tenders whole or in part keeping in view valid reasons. Conditional tenders will not be accepted.
19. Director, ICAR-IISWC reserves the right to modify any of the terms and conditions of the contract as mentioned in this tender document, at its discretion, in the interest of the job work and in public interest.
20. Successful Bidder/tenderer will have to enter into a detailed contract agreement with IISWC on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- (One hundred only) for work. The format of agreement shall be supplied along with work order.
21. No Engineer of gazetted rank or other gazetted officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
22. Decision of the Director, IISWC shall be final for any aspect of the contract and binding to all parties. Disputes arising, if any, on the contract will be settled at his level by mutual consultation and in case of failure in settlement dispute shall be referred to the sole arbitrator to be appointed by the Director, ICAR-IISWC. The decision of the sole arbitrator so appointed shall be final and binding on the parties. Arbitration proceeding shall be governed by the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time.
23. Any dispute is subject to the jurisdiction of the Court at Dehradun .

**24.Liquidated damages clause;**

1. In case firm's bid is accepted and order is placed, the work against the order should be made/executed within 30 days failing which a sum equivalent to ½ % (half percent) of the total value of the item covered in the order will be imposed as Liquidity Damage on per day basis subject to a maximum of 5% (five percent) unless extension is obtained in writing from the office on valid ground before expiry of delivery period. Thereafter the work orders automatically deemed to be cancelled with forfeiture of EMD deposited by the firm.
2. The cost of any loss/ theft/ sabotage to the Institute property shall be borne by the firm as decided by the Director, ICAR-IISWC, Dehradun.

**General Terms & Conditions**

Besides the main terms & conditions mentioned in **Annexure-II**, the contract shall be further governed with the following terms & conditions:-

1. For any further clarification regard above work, the firm may contact to Assistant Admn. Officer (S&P).
2. The specification of material to be used in the work should be as per the specification given in the tender document.
3. Catalogue of the material, if any of requisite goods should be attached with the quotation.
4. Manufacturers/supplier warranty certificates and manufacturer/government approved lab test certificate of the items to be used in work, if any should also be uploaded alongwith quotation.
5. The payment will be made after completion of work satisfactorily and submission of pre-receipted bill. The TDS, taxes etc. will be deducted from the bill as per Govt. norms.
6. In case of any loss/ theft/ sabotage to the IISWC property, the department reserves the right to impose liquidity damages.
7. In case of any loss/theft/sabotage to the manpower, property, machinery etc. of the contract, the IISWC shall not be responsible in any manner.
8. When the works / repairs and maintenance of works are carried out, the splashes and droppings from white washing, colour washing, painting etc., on walls, floor, windows, etc shall be removed and the surface cleaned simultaneously with the completion of these items of work in the individual rooms, quarters or premises etc. where the work is done: without waiting for actual completion of all the other items of work in the contract. In case the contractor fails to comply with the requirements of this clause, the Engineer-in-Charge shall have the right to get this work done at the cost of the contractor either departmentally or through any other agency. Before taking such action, the Engineer-in-Charge shall give ten days notice in writing to the contractor.
9. The contractor shall execute the whole and every part of the work in the most substantial and Workmanlike manner both as regards materials and otherwise in every respect in strict accordance with the specifications. The contractor shall also conform exactly, fully and faithfully to the design, drawings and instructions in writing in respect of the work signed by the Engineer-in-Charge and the contractor shall be furnished free of charge one copy of the contract documents together with specifications, designs, drawings and instructions as are not included in the standard specifications of Central Public Works Department specified in Schedule 'F' or in any Bureau of Indian Standard or any other, published standard or code or, Schedule of Rates or any other printed publication referred to elsewhere in the contract. The contractor shall comply with the provisions of the contract and with the care and diligence execute and maintain the works and provide all labour and materials, tools and plants including for measurements and supervision of all works, structural plans and other things of temporary or permanent nature required for such execution and maintenance in so far as the necessity for providing these, is specified or is reasonably inferred from the contract. The Contractor shall take full responsibility for adequacy, suitability and safety of all the works and methods of construction.



10. The worker deployed for execution of work should be capable of doing the assigned work.
11. The firm is advised to quote its rates after physical inspection of the site, very detailed assessment/requirements of deployment of labour and required material for completion of the assigned job. The rates to be quoted should include cost of each and every item including transportation cost, manpower cost and taxes etc. The Institute shall not bear any extra charge on any account whatsoever. No request for alteration in the rates once quoted will be permitted till the job is not completed.
12. The contractor shall discharge all his legal obligations in respect of the wages and service conditions of the workers/supervisors to be deployed by him for the execution of the work and shall also comply with all the rules and regulations and provisions of law in force that may be applicable to them from time to time.
13. The contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified the IISWC from any claims, loss or damages that may be caused to it on account of any failure to comply with the obligations under various laws. In case of any dispute, the decision of Director, IISWC shall be final and binding on the contractor.
14. The Contractor must employ adult labour only. Employment of child labour may lead to the termination of the Contract.
15. The contractor must follow C.P.W.D. safety code while executing the work. Whole responsibility will be of contractor for any lack in safety in respect of the labour employed or structure under construction / repair.
16. **The ICAR-IISWC, Dehradun is registered as “Public Funded Research Institute” with Department of Scientific & Industrial Research (DSIR), Govt. of India and the material to be purchased will be used for research purpose only. Hence as per Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India’s notifications issued from time to time, 5% GST is applicable against all scientific and technical instruments, apparatus, equipments, accessories, parts, consumables etc. being purchased for research purpose.** Institute will issue necessary certificate in this regard and also provided a copy of Certificate related to Institute’s registration with DSIR, Govt. of India.
17. The Director, IISWC, Dehradun reserves the right to reject any or all tenders in whole or in part without assigning any reason therefore. The decision of Director, IISWC, Dehradun Shall be final and binding on the Contractor/Agency in respect of clause covered under the contract.
18. The Director of IISWC reserves the right to discontinue the Contract at any time, if the work is found unsatisfactory by giving a show-cause to be replied within a week and also has the right to award the contract to any other agency at the risk and cost of current agency and excess expenditure incurred on account of this can be recovered from Security Deposit or pending bills or by rising a separate claim. The decision of Director of the Institute shall be final and binding on the contractor/agency in respect of any clause covered under the Contract.
